Tuition Rates

Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church support Adventist education with substantial church and conference subsidies. Therefore, students and/or families who are members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church are charged the **constituent rate**.

Students whose families are not members of the SDA church are charged the *non-constituent rate*.

Students who require an I-20 Form for their visas are charged the **international tuition rate**.

Most educational costs are included in tuition for grades K-12. Please refer to a list of additional charges for all grades at another section in this brochure.

Billing Procedures

The annual tuition amount is the cost of attending RAA for a school year. For your convenience, the annual tuition charge is divided into 11 installments and billed July through May. The monthly installment plan is designed to divide the cost over 11 months and does not signify the cost per month to attend RAA. A monthly statement will be emailed to the financially responsible party. Monthly payments are due and payable in accordance with the payment schedule. No refund will be given for extended absences or vacation periods.

Early Withdrawal

When a student prematurely withdraws from school, a parent or responsible party must fill out a withdrawal form with the office. A student who withdraws during the school year will have the annual tuition prorated. This may result in a credit or a balance on the account, depending on the date of withdrawal.

Mid-Year Enrollment

A student who enrolls after the beginning of the school year will have the tuition prorated with additional charges added based on grade level and the date of enrollment.

High school students may only enroll up to two weeks after the start of each semester to receive semester credit.

International Students

Students on an I-20 visa are required to pay a \$350 non-refundable application fee. These students are charged the international tuition rate which must be paid in advance, prior to the issuance of the I-20 visa.

Tuition Assistance

Redlands Adventist Academy does not want finances to be an obstacle that prevents a student from receiving an education at RAA. There are sources of tuition aid available which are outlined in the Financial Aid & Scholarship Program page on the website. The online FACTS Grant and Aid application must be completed to be considered for financial assistance. You maximize your access to financial assistance by applying early.

Registration

Outstanding accounts at RAA or other SDA schools must be cleared prior to registration at RAA.

All students must apply or re-enroll online through FACTS. Registration is not complete until the first tuition payment due has been paid.

Application Fee

A \$150 non-refundable fee for all new applications is paid upon submitting the application. Applications submitted after July 1 are considered late and will be charged a \$200 non-refundable fee.

Continuous Enrollment Fee

All re-enrolling students will be charged the continuous enrollment fee in the first week of April as follows: \$150 for the 1st child in a household, and \$100 for each additional sibling.

Financial Clearance

Tuition and fees charged to a family account must be paid in full each month to receive financial clearance for overnight trips, semester and final exams, and participation in graduation services for grades K, 8, and 12. Cash or money orders may be required for payment on delinquent accounts. **All accounts must be paid in full by Financial Clearance Day on May 17, 2024.**

Delinquent Accounts

Accounts must be kept current. Students whose accounts are more than 30 days past due will be placed on an attendance hold until the amount is paid in full or satisfactory financial arrangements are made. Students with unpaid accounts will not be permitted to take semester exams and participate in school-sponsored activities and/or trips. No refunds will be granted for any days missed due to delinquency-related withdrawal.

A family whose account has been delinquent for several months will be required to sign-up for an automatic plan the following year.

Annual Tuition Discount

Parents who choose to pay for the school year in advance should contact the business office prior to making a payment no later than July 31, 2023. The business office will apply the \$150/student discount to your account.

Tuition includes required textbooks, workbooks, and online resources K-12.

Before/After School Care

RAA offers before and after school care for the safety of the students and the convenience of the parents. Students in grades **K-8** are billed for before and after school care, students in grade **9-12** are billed for before school care only. Students **K-8** are <u>not</u> billed until 30 minutes after dismissal. The fee structure below takes into account the staggered dismissal times. Students with older siblings, will not be charged until all siblings are at KidsCare.

Before School Care

Monday - Friday 6:30am-7:30am

K-12 Rate \$5.50 per hour

7-12 No charge from 7:00am-7:30am on the days the student has 1st Period class.

Billing increments are not prorated

After School Care

Monday - Thursday

K-2 No charge until 3:00pm, \$1.50 per 15 minutes until 3:30pm

3-4 No charge until 3:15pm, \$1.50 per 15 minutes until 3:30pm

K-8 3:30pm - 6:00pm \$5.50 per hour

Billing increments are not prorated

Friday and Minimum Days

K-2 No charge until 12:15pm, \$1.50 per 15 minutes until 1:00pm

3-4 No charge until 12:30pm, \$1.50 per 15 minutes until 1:00pm

5-6 3:30pm – No charge until 12:45pm, \$1.50 per 15 minutes until 1:00pm

K-8 1:00pm - 4:00pm \$5.50 per hour (Fridays)

K-8 1:00pm - 6:00pm \$5.50 per hour (Minimum Day)

Billing increments are not prorated

There is a late charge of \$10 per 5 minutes AFTER closing. Charges are included in the statement and are due and payable in accordance with your FACTS account.

Payment Methods

Parents are encouraged to pay online using the FACTS Family Portal. Through the portal, parents may pay with credit cards and ACH. We also accept payments with checks and cash at the business office. Two-party and post-dated checks are not accepted.

SCRIP

The SCRIP program is an easy and effective way to earn money to reduce tuition and incidental costs. Credits earned will be posted to the student account in FACTS on a monthly basis. Please note that SCRIP credit is non-refundable.

SCRIP purchases can be made at the Business Office.

Part-Time Enrollment

Part-time enrollment is permitted for students who need a few classes to complement their independent study education. Students in grades 7-12 may enroll on a parttime status with administration approval. Consideration will be given on an individual basis, and acceptance will be based on availability.

The online application must be completed and the first installment paid before the first day of school. The following restrictions apply:

- Students may participate in all spiritual activities. Charges may apply depending on the activity and costs.
- Students may not participate in class trips or overnight trips unless the trip is directly connected to the academic class in which they are enrolled. If a Junior High student attends an overnight trip, a parent must be able to attend with his/her child. Charges will apply accordingly.
- Students in grades 8 and 12 cannot participate in graduation services.

Junior High

Students may enroll in a **maximum of 2 classes** per semester including sports. One sport equals one class. If a student chooses to participate in a sport, they must also take an academic class. Sports fees will not apply.

- One Class per Semester: \$1,000
- Two Classes per Semester: \$1,800

High School Classes Excluding Varsity Sports

Students may enroll in a **maximum of 2 academic** classes per semester, excluding varsity sports.

- One Class per Semester: \$1,500
- Two Classes per Semester: \$2,500

High School Classes Including Varsity Sports

A High School student enrolled in sports must enroll in additional academic classes for a total of **20 credits per semester**. Sports fees will apply.

• Cost per semester: \$4,000

All part-time requests must be approved with the first installment paid prior to the student starting, and will be based on availability.
