2025-2026 // FINANCIAL POLICIES

Tuition Rates

Members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church support Adventist education with substantial church and conference subsidies. Therefore, students and/or families who are members of the Seventh-day Adventist Church are charged the *constituent rate*.

Students whose families are not members of the SDA church are charged the **non-constituent rate**.

Students who require an I-20 Form for their visas are charged the **international tuition rate**.

Most educational costs are included in tuition for grades K-12. Please refer to a list of additional charges for all grades at another section in this brochure.

Billing Procedures

The annual tuition amount is the cost of attending RAA for a school year. For your convenience, the annual tuition charge is divided into 11 installments and billed July through May. The monthly installment plan is designed to divide the cost over 11 months and does not signify the cost per month to attend RAA. A monthly statement will be emailed to the financially responsible party. Monthly payments are due and payable in accordance with the payment schedule. No refund will be given for extended absences or vacation periods.

Early Withdrawal

When a student prematurely withdraws from school, a parent or responsible party must fill out a withdrawal form with the office. A student who withdraws during the school year will have the annual tuition prorated. This may result in a credit or a balance on the account, depending on the date of withdrawal.

Mid-Year Enrollment

A student who enrolls after August 31 will have the tuition prorated based on the date of enrollment.

Financial Clearance

Tuition and fees charged to a family account must be paid in full each month to receive financial clearance for overnight trips, semester and final exams, and participation in graduation services for grades K, 8, and 12. Cash or money orders may be required for payment on delinquent accounts. All accounts must be paid in full by Financial Clearance Day on May 15, 2026.

Registration & Enrollment at RAA

At RAA, we've created a straightforward registration and enrollment process that includes continuous enrollment for returning students.

*All application and registration fees are non-refundable.

New Student Application Deadlines & Non-Refundable Fees

- Early Bird Application: A \$100 fee per application is open from the first business day of November through the end of January.
- **Priority Application:** A \$150 fee per application is open from the first business day of February through the end of April. The priority deadline for new siblings is the end of January.
- **Regular Application:** A \$200 fee per application is open from May through June.
- Late Application: Any applications submitted on July 1st or later are considered late and will be charged a \$250 fee per application.

Continuous Enrollment for Returning Students

Once your child is enrolled, they are considered enrolled until they graduate unless you inform us otherwise via FACTS using our opt-out process. Enrollment is not complete until the first tuition payment has been made.

If you are a returning family and do not notify us that you will not be returning, we'll assume your student is re-enrolling for the next academic year. All reenrolling students will be charged a continuous enrollment fee in the first week of April: \$150 for the first child and \$100 for each additional sibling. Students who opted out but decide to return after July 1st will be charged a \$200 non-refundable fee. All registered families will receive communications about continuous enrollment before the new school year.

Please note that all outstanding accounts at RAA or other SDA schools must be cleared before registration can be completed at RAA. If you have any questions, please contact the business office.

Discounts

Redlands Adventist Academy offers the following tuition discounts:

Annual Tuition Discount

Parents who choose to pay for the school year in advance should contact the business office prior to making a payment no later than July 31, 2025. The business office will apply the \$300/student discount to your account.

Multiple Child Discount

Families with more than three students in attendance will receive a 25% discount on tuition starting with the 4th child.

Tuition Assistance

Redlands Adventist Academy does not want finances to be an obstacle that prevents a student from receiving an education at RAA. There are sources of tuition aid available which are outlined in the Financial Aid & Scholarship Program page on the website. The online FACTS Grant and Aid application must be completed to be considered for financial assistance. You maximize your access to financial assistance by applying early.

Delinquent Accounts

Accounts must be kept current. Students whose accounts are more than 30 days past due will be placed on an attendance hold until the amount is paid in full or satisfactory financial arrangements are made. Students with unpaid accounts will not be permitted to take semester exams and participate in school-sponsored activities and/or trips. No refunds will be granted for any days missed due to delinquency-related withdrawal.

A family whose account has been delinquent for several months will be required to sign-up for an automatic plan the following year.

School Lunch Program

The Redlands Adventist Academy (RAA) offers a vegetarian and vegan lunch program in partnership with a local vendor. This program is available to all RAA students.

- Availability: Lunch service is provided Monday through Thursday. On minimum days, sack lunches will be prepared.
- Ordering: All lunch orders must be placed through the FACTS Family Portal. While ordering on the day of service is permitted up to 9:00 a.m., it is highly recommended that orders be placed the day prior to ensure timely preparation. Any lunch placed after 9:00am on the day of is considered an emergency lunch.
- **Pricing:** The standard cost per meal is \$8.50.
- Emergency Lunches: A limited number of emergency lunches are available for students who have not pre-ordered. These meals are provided at a cost of \$10.00 and will be charged directly to your family's account.
- Cancellation Policy: Please note that there are no refunds for canceled lunches. However, parents may contact the vendor directly at najwa@najwas.com or by text at (909) 264-0340 to request that an unused meal be transferred to another day.

Before/After School Care

RAA provides before and after school care for the safety of students and the convenience of parents.

Before school care is available from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. After school care hours are Monday through Thursday until 6:00 p.m. and Friday until 4:00 p.m.

BEFORE SCHOOL CARE: (Grades K-12) \$1.75/15-minutes for each student.

AFTER SCHOOL CARE: (Grades K-8) \$1.75/15-minutes starting 30 minutes after dismissal.

For after school care, students remaining after closing will be billed at a rate of \$10 per 5-minute increment.

All charges are posted monthly and are due and payable through your FACTS account.

Part-Time Enrollment (grades 9-12 only)

Part-time enrollment is permitted for students who need a few classes to complement their independent study education. Students in **grades 9-12** may enroll on a part-time status for a maximum of 2 classes. Consideration will be given on an individual basis, and acceptance will be based on availability.

The online application must be completed and the first installment paid before the first day of school. Refer to other guidelines and policies in accordance with the Registrar's office. All other applicable financial policies apply to students on a part-time status.

Students may enroll in a **maximum of 2 academic classes.** Tuition for part-time students is <u>not</u> prorated.

International Students

Students on an I-20 visa are required to pay a \$350 non-refundable application fee. These students are charged the international tuition rate which must be paid in advance, prior to the issuance of the I-20 visa.

Application Fee: \$150 non-refundable fee for all new applicants, paid upon submission of application. Applications submitted after July 1st require a \$200 non-refundable application fee.

Continuous Enrollment Fee: \$150 non-refundable fee for all returning students. See Continuous Enrollment page on website for more information. Students who have opted-out and choose to return after July 1st will be charged a \$200 non-refundable fee.
